Welcome sponsors, supporters & players to the 2010 player auction

WHAT IS THE PLAYER AUCTION?

This player auction is a key fundraiser for the club & now gives everyone a chance to buy a player grouping & support the club. It's your chance to own your favorite player & follow his or her form for the entire 2010 season & making some money for your support.

The auction is designed not only to be a fundraiser for the club but to give players, parents & supporters the opportunity to earn some cash along the way.

Some good investing can see you walk away with a very tidy profit!

HOW IT WORKS

Every player from the football & netball club has been placed in groups of five or six. There are 22 groups of players to be auctioned. These groups will be auctioned off on Saturday 24th April to the highest bidder on the night.

Every week throughout the entire season, including the rounds already played, the player voted best on ground or court will be the AUCTION PLAYER for that round.

The coach of each team will determine the best player for the round.

WEEKLY PRIZES

Here's where you can make some money.

Total pool of money raised will be split - 70% will return to purchasers & 30% will remain with the club (it is a fundraiser!). For example, if \$10,000 is raised- \$3000 will stay with the club & \$7000 will be allocated to the prize money pool.

The money allocated to the prize pool will be divided into 18 rounds to create a weekly prize pool, which will then be spread among the buyers of the seven best Geelong Amateur players each week.

The weekly prize pool split will be allocated as a percentage as follows:

- Senior Football - 38%
- Reserve Football - 15%
- U18 Football - 7%
- A Grade Netball - 15%
- B Grade Netball - 11%
- C Grade Netball - 7%
- D Grade Netball - 7%

We will advise you at the end of the night what the dollar value will be per week.

Remember - With only seven players making up a netball team, the chances are great of your netballer gaining multiple awards during the year.

HOW DO I PURCHASE?

To purchase your favourite players or the player group you think will be a good investment simply outbid your rivals in the auction!

ALL groups will have a reserve.

DO I HAVE TO PURCHASE A GROUP BY MYSELF?

The auction isn't all about single purchases. So make up some syndicates & purchase a group with your friends.

All purchases will have the players of the group & the owner of the group displayed in the clubrooms, with the results of the auction players in every grade of football & netball.

A FEW RULES

A 50% deposit must be made by Thursday April 29, 2010 with the balance paid by round 6, Saturday May 8, 2010. Ideally groups are to be paid for on the night. We will come see you after the completion of the auction or to organise payment at a later date. We accept cash, cheque, EFTPOS, Visa & MasterCard.

Should the purchase be made by a syndicate, it is the responsibility of the person performing the bidding to ensure payment in full is made for the purchase.

Cheques will be issued after every six rounds to the group owners.

EXAMPLE PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR 2010

Assuming we raised \$12,000 on the night.

\$3,600 (30%) is retained by the club.

\$8,400 (70%) is returned to the purchasers as the total prize pool money.

The total prize pool money is divided into 18 rounds to give a weekly prize pool of \$466.67

If one of your players is anointed the AUCTION PLAYER for the round the rewards are as such:

Senior Football (38%) - \$177.33

Reserve Football (15%) - \$70

U18 Football (7%) - \$32.67

A Grade Netball (15%) - \$70

B Grade Netball (11%) - \$51.33

C Grade Netball (7%) - \$32.67

D Grade Netball (7%) - \$32.67

Total weekly prize pool (100%) - \$466.67
