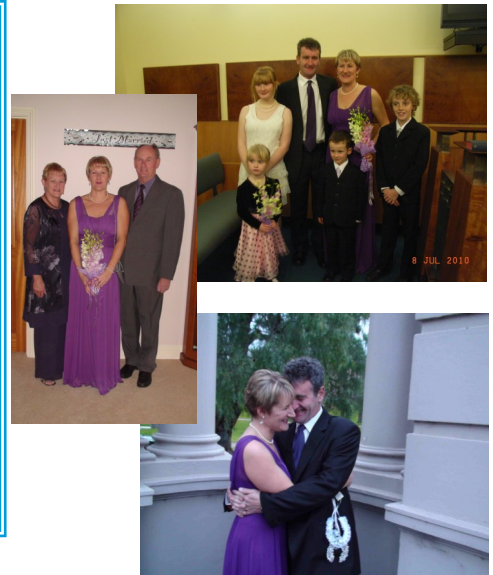
!!!CONGRATULATIONS JULIE & DARREN!!!
